Executive Summary

The resolution would ratify Order 2020-21 and Order 2020-22 issued by the Health Director.

Discussion

Section 11-98 of the City Code requires any order of the Health Director which is in effect for more than twenty-one (21) days to be ratified by the City Council. The Council is requested to consider and ratify Order 2020-21, which went into effect on March 24, 2021, and consider and ratify Order 2020-22, which extends order 2020-21 to May 12, 2021. Ratification of the order at this time is advisable so that the order may be extended past the twenty-one (21) day period without further amendments if deemed necessary by the Health Director.
