Re: Authorizing a Long Term Street Closure of a Portion of Rollins Street between Hitt Street and Virginia Avenue

## Executive Summary

Staff has prepared for Council consideration a resolution authorizing the University of Missouri to close a portion of Rollins Street, between Hitt Street and Virginia Avenue, for repair and partial reconstruction of three deteriorated steam manholes in the westbound lane of Rollins Street.

## Discussion

The University of Missouri has requested a long term street closure of Rollins Street, between Hitt Street and Virginia Avenue, beginning Monday May 15, 2017 through Friday, August 11, 2017, for repair and partial reconstruction of three deteriorated steam manholes in the westbound lane of Rollins Street. This work will require excavation to a depth of approximately 14 feet, and approximately 400 feet of both eastbound and westbound lanes of Rollins Street will be closed for this three month period.

This work is being completed on the University campus; therefore, no other businesses will be affected by the closure. Staff has reviewed the traffic control plans (attached) and has no issues with the request. The University of Missouri shall be responsible for all signs and barricades necessary for the protection and convenience of the general public, and shall be responsible for notifications to the media and emergency personnel. The University of Missouri is exempt from any public inconvenience fee.
