A RESOLUTION

accepting the Neighborhood Traffic Management Program 2025 Year End Report Summary; authorizing staff to complete the public improvement process for proposed installation of traffic calming devices on Whitegate Drive, pursue traffic calming projects on Hoylake Drive and Highlands Parkway, pursue the reinstallation of traffic calming devices on Bodie Drive, and continue to address Level 1 traffic calming projects per the Neighborhood Traffic Management Program guidelines.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:


SECTION 1. The City Council hereby accepts the Neighborhood Traffic Management Program 2025 Year End Report Summary as set forth in "Exhibit A" attached hereto.

SECTION 2. The City Council hereby authorizes the following traffic calming projects in 2026:

- Complete the public process for the proposed installation of traffic calming devices on Whitegate Drive, and potentially install traffic calming devices dependent on future Council direction.
- Pursue a traffic calming project on Hoylake Drive.
- Pursue a traffic calming project on Highlands Parkway.
- Pursue a traffic calming project on Bodie Drive for the reinstallation of devices.
- Continue to address Level 1 traffic calming projects per the Neighborhood Traffic Management Program guidelines.
