Executive Summary

An ordinance has been prepared authorizing the Interim City Manager to sign an amendment to an agreement signed November 19, 2013 between Tyler Technologies, Inc. and the City of Columbia. The amendment authorizes the purchase of Tyler/Digital Health Department.

Discussion

This amendment will authorize the purchase of Tyler/Digital Health Department. This software will allow health inspections of facilities such as restaurants, grocery stores, and swimming pools to be managed electronically, streamlining the entire permitting and inspection process for staff and the regulated establishments. This software will also provide more transparency to the public by allowing for online inspection results across environmental health programs. Savings money will be used for the purchase and Boone County will share in the cost for subsequent years.

Fiscal Impact

Short-Term Impact: \$79540 to be paid out of PHHS savings.

Long-Term Impact: Approximately \$26,500 annually with reassessment of fees across all program areas.
