

Introduced by McDavid Council Bill No. R 90-10

A RESOLUTION

establishing a Source Water Protection Plan Task Force to develop a Source Water Protection Plan for the City of Columbia's water supply.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Council hereby establishes a Source Water Protection Plan Task Force to develop a Source Water Protection Plan for the City of Columbia's water supply consisting of twelve (12) members as follows:

- a. Four City employees appointed by the City Manager;
- b. A representative of the University of Missouri-Columbia appointed by the University;
- c. A representative of Public Water Supply District #9 appointed by District #9;
- d. A representative of the Missouri Department of Conservation appointed by the Department of Conservation;
- e. A member of the Water and Light Advisory Board chosen by that Board; and
- f. Four (4) members who shall be residents of the City of Columbia appointed by the City Council.

The Water and Light Advisory Board shall be given the opportunity to review the list of applicants and provide comments to the City Council prior to the Council making appointments to the Task Force. In making appointments to the Task Force, the City Council and Water and Light Advisory Board shall consider prior service on a City board or commission, professional credentials or participation in civic, business or professional organizations as key qualifications for membership.


SECTION 2. The Task Force shall follow the "Guidelines for Developing a Source Water Protection Plan" published by the Missouri Department of Natural Resources and attached hereto as "Exhibit A." The content of the Source Water Protection Plan shall be as outlined in these guidelines.

SECTION 3. The Task Force shall meet monthly and provide quarterly updates of their progress to the Water and Light Advisory Board. The Task Force shall provide an annual update to the City Council.

SECTION 4. The Water and Light Department shall provide the Task Force with necessary staff support.
