**A RESOLUTION**

SECTION 3. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a data sharing and HIPAA business associate agreement with Bringing Families Together. The form and content of the agreement shall be substantially as set forth in "Attachment C" attached hereto and made a part hereof.
