Re: Authorizing a development agreement with Jailhouse Rock, LLC to extend water main service to property at 107 North Ninth Street.

## Executive Summary

Staff has prepared for Council consideration an ordinance authorizing the City Manager to execute an agreement with Jailhouse Rock LLC in the amount not to exceed \$20,000 for the extension of a public water line to property located at 107 North Ninth Street.

## Discussion

Jailhouse Rock, LLC is in the process of renovating property located at 107 North Ninth Street. During construction it was determined that the existing water line came from a meter in the neighbor's basement and was not sufficient for a fire suppression system. Prior to that, there had been a water line that came down N. Ninth Street but had been abandoned.

The property has historic relevance as it was built in 1901 and served as Columbia's City Hall. It originally had two south two bays with one as the police office that had a door in the back where the jail was located. The other bay served as the City Office. Presumably, the city clerk or another official was there, and up the stairs was the meeting room where City meetings were held. A few years later the third bay on the north side bordering the alley was built. It was the city's first fire office and across the alley, or in the rear, there was a livery stable where the horses and the firewagon or wagons were kept. The city left this location within a decade and moved to N Seventh Street.

This agreement allows the property owners to extend a 6-inch water main service approximately 160 feet from the existing 8-inch water line on E. Walnut Street. The City shall pay for 50% of the project or up to a maximum of \$20,000.

The work will be done by the property owners meeting all required city codes and regulations.
