## **AMENDMENT #02 TO CONTRACT DH220049859**

**CONTRACT TITLE:** COVID-19 And Adult Vaccination Supplemental

**CONTRACT PERIOD:** February 1, 2021 through June 30, 2025

The Department of Health and Senior Services hereby extends the above referenced contract through June 30, 2025; therefore Section 1.1 is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with revised Section 1.1 as follows:

- 1. Delete Section 1.1 in its entirety and replace with revised Section 1.1 as follows:
  - 1.1 The contract amount shall not exceed the Contractor's displayed funding amount on the COVID-19 Vaccine Incentive Advance Payments Table located at <a href="https://health.mo.gov/living/healthcondiseases/communicable/novel-coronavirus-lpha/">https://health.mo.gov/living/healthcondiseases/communicable/novel-coronavirus-lpha/</a> for the period of February 1, 2021 through June 30, 2025.

In addition, the Department of Health and Senior Services desires to amend the above-referenced contract in accordance with the following:

- 2. Delete Section 4.1 in its entirety and replace with revised Section 4.1 as follows:
  - 4.1 The Contractor shall ensure that the recommended COVID-19 vaccine is available for underserved, high-risk populations for adult and/or Vaccine for Children (VFC) eligible children.
- 3. Delete Section 4.4 in its entirety and replace with revised Section 4.4 as follows:
  - 4.4 The Contractor shall increase vaccine confidence through education, outreach, and partnerships for COVID-19 and all other Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP) recommended vaccinations for all ages.
  - 4.4.1 The Contractor shall partner, plan, and implement vaccination activities with critical organizations, **in priority order**:
    - a. Long-term care facilities (LTCFs), including independent living facilities, assisted living centers, and nursing homes
    - b. Non-traditional provider and locations that serve high-risk populations
    - c. Other partners that serve underserved populations
    - d. Occupational health settings for large employers
    - e. Churches or religious institutions
    - f. Federally Qualified Health Centers (FQHCs), including Community Health Centers (CHCs)
    - g. Organizations and businesses that employ critical workforce
    - h. Colleges and Universities

- 4.4.2 The Contractor shall promote COVID-19 vaccine and other adult vaccinations to increase vaccine confidence in racial and ethnic minority groups and increase accessibility for people with disabilities. For more information, please refer to:

- 4.4.3 The Contractor shall enhance/amplify consistent messaging (including translation) utilizing reliable sources including the State of Missouri publicly available media (print/digital) to promote COVID-19 vaccination especially among underserved populations by December 31, 2021. For more information, please refer to: <a href="https://covidvaccine.mo.gov/toolkit/">https://covidvaccine.mo.gov/toolkit/</a>.
- 4.4.4 The Contractor shall address vaccine education efforts to include topics on addressing vaccine misinformation, increase vaccine confidence and vaccine uptake to racial and ethnic minority groups and to increase accessibility for people with disabilities.
- 4. Delete Section 4.5 in its entirety and replace with revised Section 4.5 as follows
  - 4.5 The Contractor shall develop and implement community engagement strategies to promote COVID-19 and all ACIP recommended vaccines for all ages.
  - 4.5.1 The Contractor shall implement the CDC COVID-19 Vaccine Rapid Community Assessment Guide or a current Community Health Needs Assessment (less than 3 years old) to diagnose potential barriers and identity solutions to low vaccine uptake or vaccine confidence in communities of high social vulnerability and submit by September 1, 2021.   - 4.5.2 The Contractor shall engage in at least one quarterly bidirectional conversation with diverse communities to promote COVID-19 and adult vaccinations through June 30, 2025.
  - 4.5.3 The Contractor shall develop and implement community engagement strategies to promote COVID-19 and adult vaccinations:

The Contractor shall choose at least one option to implement:

- a. Conduct a county level digital campaign using CDC developed materials.
- b. Provide printed adult vaccination materials to patients.
- c. Implement direct adult immunization mailers (postage paid).
- d. Develop and print LPHA specific adult immunization fliers for county healthcare providers.

All other terms, conditions and provisions of the above referenced contract shall remain the same and apply hereto.
