AN ORDINANCE

authorizing a road relinquishment agreement with the County of Boone as part of the Route K and Old Plank Road roundabout improvement project; accepting a quit claim deed; directing the City Clerk to record the deed; and fixing the time when this ordinance shall become effective.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a road relinquishment agreement with the County of Boone as part of the Route K and Old Plank Road roundabout improvement project. The form and content of the agreement shall be substantially as set forth in "Attachment A" attached hereto and made a part hereof.

SECTION 2. The City of Columbia accepts the following quit claim deed:

Quit Claim Deed for right-of-way purposes associated with construction of the Route K and Old Plank Road roundabout improvement project, from the County of Boone, dated July 18, 2024, a copy of which is attached to this ordinance.

SECTION 3. The City Clerk is authorized and directed to have the deed recorded in the office of the Boone County Recorder of Deeds.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
