

I had lost your name in info but thankfully got it today from Garrett. I have such deep appreciation for all the wonderful work that all of you at Columbia Park and Rec do!

I'm still fairly new to town and learning my way around after living in San Francisco for 51 years. Kinda like being on another planet but I'm slowly acclimating. I miss the ocean so much and miss walking the on the beach there with Fanny every day.

I'm contacting you again because as a very long time and avid environmental steward and activist and am presently involved in several ecology campaigns. But I still have some energy left to support the work you guys do each day.

There are 3 topics of interest to me that I wanted to at least have on the radar for whoever will be leading the meeting tomorrow afternoon (i saw it posted at Twin Lakes) Unfortunately I won't be able to attend that.

1. I love and appreciate all you do regarding dog waste....including the availability of bags, the GREAT SIGNAGE and your dedicated emptying of the cans. I was so grateful to see that you actually WROTE the warning that dog waste CARRIES DISEASE. Thank you. My vet is very adamant about that. I would be glad (maybe in autumn or next spring) to help with a campaign of some kind to inspire more mindful awareness and pick up by dog owners. I know that sometimes people get distracted but I also witness lots of careless dog ownership. I try to stay very positive and proactive but also people could do much better. As a retired school teacher I have done many sign making and consciousness raising campaigns and would be glad to help with another.







- 2. I sure wish we could some raise money to have even some small walking path in the SMALL DOG area. Now it's all grass and poop is so hard to see and hard to navigate pick up from grass. A small path like the one for the large dogs near the lake would be so wonderful. I would be willing to help with a fundraiser to build a little path/ trail for that area if this would be possible.

Please restore the Little Mates area with a general swimming area. South of Broadway needs a public swim area desperately.

The closure of Little Mates has left a gaping hole in public swimming areas south of Broadway. Central Columbia has Douglas Park, though since it's envisioned as a neighborhood park, parking is limited. North/Northeast Columbia has Albert-Oakland, east Columbia has Stephen's Lake, and far East Columbia has Lake of the Woods. There is nothing south of Broadway except for Twin Lakes and that has been out of commission for years now. Taxes were renewed to repair and/or improve in 2021, and the replacement of the water feature would not be an improvement for the park. By making a full aquatic center at Twin Lakes, you'll reduce pressure on the ARC (which is out of service due to overuse) and the other public swimming areas, and recognize that the south and west side of Columbia have the same legitimate needs as other areas of the city. The presence of private swim clubs does not override this need as as not all families can afford access to the clubs. Please do not use tax money to reduce the utility of Twin Lakes Park, but restore it's original vision as an aquatic location for Columbia south of Broadway.

My name is Robert and I live within a couple hundred yards of Twin Lakes. My family and I visit Twin Lakes on average 5 days a week, year-round and have done so customarily for years. Like many who live in the area, I am a father to small children. On the street behind me, there are 15 children under age 18. The area surrounding Twin Lakes is home to a large community of growing families who regularly visit Twin Lakes and who have waited years for Little Mates Cove to reopen.

There has been a stir in the community lately that is evident not only at Twin Lakes but also on Facebook, Nextdoor and other community apps that the city has allocated a substantial sum of money for the expansion of the dog park at Twin Lakes. For years now, we in the community have bemoaned the closure of Little Mates Cove and eagerly anticipated its reopening, only to now hear that the massive dog park is receiving priority over the needs of the children. What is the need for a bigger dog park? It isn't ever crowded. It is massive to begin with. Fix and reopen the water park for the children!
