A RESOLUTION

authorizing Rader Hospitality Company, L.L.C. temporary closures of a portion of the alleyway located north of Locust Street and between Sixth Street and Seventh Street; granting temporary waivers from the requirements of Section 16-185 of the City Code to allow possession and consumption of alcoholic beverages and Section 16-258.1 of the City Code to allow amplified sound exceeding a distance of 300 feet for the area associated with outdoor events.

Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Columbia, Missouri, as follows:

SECTION 1. The City Council hereby grants Rader Hospitality Company, L.L.C. temporary closures of a portion of the alleyway located north of Locust Street and between Sixth Street and Seventh Street adjacent to 119 S. Seventh Street as follows:

- August 28, 2026 from 12:00 p.m. through August 29, 2026 to 1:30 a.m.
- August 29, 2026 from 12:00 p.m. through August 30, 2026 to 1:30 a.m.

SECTION 2. The City Council hereby grants Radar Hospitality Company, L.L.C. temporary waivers from the requirements of Section 16-185 of the City Code so that the possession of an open container of alcohol and consumption of an alcoholic beverage, and Section 16-258.1 of the City Code to allow amplified sound exceeding a distance of 300 feet, along a portion of the alleyway located north of Locust Street and between Sixth Street and Seventh Street adjacent to 119 S. Seventh Street as follows:

- August 28, 2026 from 12:00 p.m. through August 29, 2026 to 1:30 a.m.
- August 29, 2026 from 12:00 p.m. through August 30, 2026 to 1:30 a.m.
