A request by Van Matre Law Firm, P.C. for a conditional use permit (CUP) to allow for a drive-up facility (often described as a drive-through) on approximately 1.13 acres of M-DT (Mixed use- Downtown) zoned property for a Raising Cane's Restaurant. The property is located southwest of the intersection of Providence Road and Locust Street and is addressed 201 S. Providence Road. Restaurants are a permitted use in the M-DT; drive-up facilities are a conditional, accessory use which require a conditional use permit subject to the provisions of Chapter 29-6.4(m). (Ward 1)
