Re: Resolution authorizing an amendment to the contract between the City of Columbia

and GunBusters, LLC as originally agreed to in R39-19A.

Executive Summary

Staff has prepared for Council consideration a resolution authorizing the Chief of Police and City Manager to execute an agency receipt/agent authorization with GUNBUSTERS, LLC for firearm destruction on an as needed basis.

Discussion

Staff would request the passing of a resolution authorizing the Chief of Police and City Manager to execute an agency receipt/agent authorization contract, as amended, with GUNBUSTERS, LLC, for the destruction of firearms. The First Amendment to the Agreement is attached hereto as Exhibit 1.

The language of the proposed amendment will address the passage of the Second Amendment Preservation Act, signed into law on June 12, 2021, by Governor Parson. To ensure the City complies with the Second Amendment Preservation Act the proposed amendment removes language regarding federal gun laws.
