A RESOLUTION

setting a public hearing; declaring the necessity for the proposed installation of traffic calming devices on Bray Avenue between Fairview Road and Bray Court; stating the nature of and the estimate of the cost of the proposed improvements; providing source of funds for payment for the proposed improvements; and providing for compliance with the prevailing wage law.

WHEREAS, virtual interested parties meetings for the proposed installation of traffic calming devices on Bray Avenue between Fairview Road and Bray Court were held by the Public Works Department on November 30, 2020 through December 11, 2020 and June 14, 2021 through June 25, 2021, and an in-person interested parties meeting was held on October 14, 2021.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. A public hearing in respect to the proposed public improvements set forth herein will be held in the Council Chamber of the City Hall Building, 701 E. Broadway, Columbia, Missouri, at 7:00 p.m. on January 3, 2022. The City Clerk shall cause notice of this hearing to be published in a newspaper published in the City.

SECTION 2. The City Council deems the proposed installation of traffic calming devices on Bray Avenue between Fairview Road and Bray Court necessary to the welfare and improvement of the City but desires to hear from the public prior to taking further action to authorize construction of the project. Specific improvements include the construction of four (4) speed humps and one (1) speed table at the following locations along Bray Avenue:

- Speed hump near 3009 Bray Avenue.
- Speed hump near 3105 Bray Avenue.
- Speed hump near 3211 Bray Avenue.
- Speed hump near 3413 Bray Avenue.
- Speed table at the intersection of Bray Avenue and Cunningham Road.

SECTION 3. The nature and scope of the proposed improvement project shall consist of furnishing all labor, materials, transportation, insurance and all other items, accessories and incidentals thereto necessary for the complete construction of the improvements. Following the public hearing the City Council shall determine whether it is in the public interest to make the proposed public improvements or any part thereof.

SECTION 4. The estimated cost of this proposed improvement project is \$25,000.00.

SECTION 5. Payment for this proposed improvement project shall be made from Annual Traffic Calming Funds and such other funds as may be lawfully appropriated.

SECTION 6. Any work done in connection with the construction of the proposed improvement project specified above shall be in compliance with the provisions of the prevailing wage laws of the State of Missouri.
