Re: Amending the FY2022 annual budget by appropriating funds related to the procurement of Aqueous Film Forming Foam (AFFF) testing equipment for Columbia Regional Airport

## Executive Summary

The Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) awarded a grant to Columbia Regional Airport for procurement of AFFF testing equipment to be used for Aircraft Rescue and Firefighting vehicles at the Columbia Regional Airport. Staff is requesting to appropriate \$2,476.76 from the Federal Contributions account to the Aqueous Film Foam project account.

## Discussion

The FAA has recommended that airport operators use AFFF, which is a highly efficient fire suppression agent in Aircraft Rescue and Firefighting vehicles. To assist with the procurement of this equipment, the FAA awarded a grant in the amount of \$24,757.76 to Columbia Regional Airport. To date, \$22,282 has been appropriated from the Federal Revenue account to the AFFF testing equipment project account, so an additional \$2,476.76 is needed to be appropriated from the Federal Contributions account. This is eligible for 100% reimbursement by the FAA.

## Fiscal Impact

Short-Term Impact: The AFFF testing equipment cost is \$24,757.76. Staff is requesting \$2,476.76 to be appropriated from Federal Contributions.
