Re: Boone County, Missouri - Live Well Boone County Contract

Executive Summary

An ordinance authorizing the City Manager to sign the renewal to the Purchase of Services agreement between Boone County, Missouri and the City of Columbia for Live Well Boone County.

Discussion

Boone County wishes to continue purchasing services from Public Health and Human Services for various activities associated with Live Well Boone County. This renewal will provide funding to continue the Live Well by Faith wellness initiative in partnership with local Black churches to reduce disparities in heart disease and diabetes death rates. Other health promotion related services are also included with this agreement including tobacco use prevention education; an E-cigarette prevention campaign; and grocery store tours and nutrition classes.
