Executive Summary

Continuation of unspent grant funds received from the National League of Cities for climate action.

Discussion

In late FY2020 the City of Columbia received technical support and \$10,000 in grant funds from the National League of Cities (NLC) to support climate action activities. A portion of the funds were spent in FY2021 to develop and pilot a neighborhood climate action ambassadors program. The remaining funds were not accounted for in the FY2022 budget. This ordinance is to authorize continuation of the unspent grant funds
