Re: Amend the FY22 Budget to Finalize the Business License Rebate Program

## Executive Summary

This amendment will allow for the final payments of the Business License Rebate program. This program was introduced in FY21 as a response to the COVID-19 pandemic, to aid the City's restaurants and bars.

## Discussion

In May of 2021, the City Council approved a program that would rebate bars and restaurants business license fees that were paid during the City's State of Emergency. This program ran through the end of calendar year 2021, but there were 5 businesses that the City needed additional information from to process the payments. To fulfill these request, we will need to appropriate approximately \$5,000.
