AMENDMENT

to the

AGREEMENT BETWEEN COLUMBIA SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 93 AND THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, FOR THE HICKMAN HIGH SCHOOL SWIMMING POOL POOL HEATER IMPROVEMENTS

This Amendment to the 2021 Agreement between the **City Of Columbia** ("City"), and **Columbia School District No. 93**, ("District") is made as of the date of the last signatory noted below.

RECITALS

- A. WHEREAS, on June 8, 2021, City and District entered into an Agreement ("2021 Agreement") for cost sharing related to the replacement of the pool heater at Hickman High School swimming pool; and
- B. WHEREAS, the Parties initially estimated the total cost of the project would be no more than thirtyseven thousand dollars, but have since determined that the total estimated cost of the project may have increased by forty thousand dollars;
- C. WHEREAS, the Parties still wish to equally share the total final project costs less any donations received from Columbia Swim Club; and
- D. WHEREAS, the Parties hereto desire to formally amend the 2021 Agreement with this Amendment (hereinafter "Amendment") and desire to be bound by the terms contained in the 2021 Agreement as amended or supplemented by those terms contained in this Amendment.

<u>AMENDMENT</u>

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual benefit to be derived by the parties, it is agreed to amend the 2021 Agreement, as follows:

- 1. The first sentence of Section 2 of the 2021 Agreement shall be removed.
- 2. All other terms of the 2021 Agreement shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect.
