Re: Report: Hinkson Creek Collaborative Adaptive Management (CAM) Progress Reports

2019 and 2020 from the CAM Stakeholder Committee

Executive Summary

The Hinkson Creek Collaborative Adaptive Management (CAM) Stakeholders and Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System (MS4) permit holders (City of Columbia, County of Boone, and University of Missouri) have prepared the CAM Progress Report 2019 and CAM Progress Report 2020. The purpose of these reports are to present a summary of the activities of the Stakeholder group and the actions taken as part of the CAM process.

Discussion

In April 2012, the City agreed to the Collaborative Adaptive Management process (CAM) to address the Total Maximum Daily Load (TMDL) for Hinkson Creek. The CAM is a five party agreement negotiated to settle the Hinkson Creek TMDL and includes the City, Boone County, the University of Missouri (MS4 - municipal separate storm sewer system - partners), the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and the Missouri Department of Natural Resources (DNR). The CAM agreement allows a wide range of activities to contribute to reaching water quality goals. The goal of the CAM agreement is to find the most effective approach or approaches for improving Hinkson Creek rather than committing to one predetermined approach which may not be as effective.

The actions during the 2019 year include conclusion of monitoring the Forum Level Spreader project and the resultant presentation to Stakeholders, preparations to apply for a USDA Regional Conservation Partnership Program grant, Hinkson Creek Land Management Workshop and completion or continuation of four water quality studies on Hinkson Creek.

The actions during the 2020 year include continuation of the Macroinvertebrate Data Mining Project and a University of Missouri Watershed Water Quality Assessment and approval for a USGS Comprehensive Chemical Sampling project at the Hinkson Creek streamguage site.

The CAM website, https://www.helpthehinkson.org/, is updated regularly to provide meeting minutes for each of the committees as well as more information regarding the CAM process.
