## A RESOLUTION

designating an official authorized to file and execute drinking water, wastewater and stormwater infrastructure grant applications with the Missouri Department of Natural Resources for State Fiscal Recovery Funds under the American Rescue Plan Act (2021).

WHEREAS, the State of Missouri received approximately \$2.7 billion in State Fiscal Recovery Funds under the American Rescue Plan Act (2021); and

WHEREAS, allowable spending under federal regulations for American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds include investments to improve access to clean drinking water, and support for vital wastewater and stormwater infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, under the terms of Sec. 602(c) of the ARPA and the U.S. Department of Treasury regulations, the State of Missouri has authorized the making of grants to authorized applicants to aid in the completion of specific public projects.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Andrew Wyatt, Grants Administrator, is hereby authorized and designated to execute and file applications on behalf of the City of Columbia, Missouri with the State of Missouri for grant funding to aid in the completion of a lead service line inventory, or drinking water, wastewater, and/or stormwater projects.

SECTION 2. Andrew Wyatt, Grants Administrator, is hereby authorized and directed to furnish such information as the Missouri Department of Natural Resources may reasonably request in connection with any such application which is herein authorized, to sign all necessary documents on behalf of the applicant, to furnish such assurances to the Missouri Department of Natural Resources as may be required by law or regulation, and to receive payment on behalf of the applicant.
