### Executive Summary

An ordinance authorizing the City Manager to sign contract amendment number one to the agreement between Missouri Children's Trust Fund and Boone County, delegating the performance of the Brighter Beginnings program from Boone County to the City of Columbia.

#### Discussion

This is an amendment to an agreement between Missouri Children's Trust Fund and Boone County for the development and coordination of the Brighter Beginnings program. Boone County has sub-contracted with the City of Columbia for the performance of the project to date. The amendment replaces Boone County with the City of Columbia as the contracted entity. No appropriation is needed as funds were already budgeted for FY2022 based on the sub-contract with Boone County. Program expenses will continue to be entirely offset by the revenue from the agreement.
