Re: Granting a temporary waiver from the requirements of Section 16-258 of the City Code to allow amplified family-friendly music for a neighborhood concert.

Executive Summary

Staff has prepared for Council consideration a resolution granting a waiver from the requirements of Section 16-258 of the City Code to allow amplified family-friendly music for a neighborhood concert on Friday, June 24, 2022.

Discussion

Mike Nolan, of FPC Live, LLC., has requested waiver of ordinance Sec. 16-258 to have amplified music for a neighborhood concert on private property in the "Old Hawthorne" neighborhood. This event will take place on Friday, June 24, 2022 from 6:00 p.m. until 11:00 p.m.

Per ordinance, a waiver is required when amplified sound can be heard more than 100 feet away from the source outside of the downtown foot print. Estimated attendance for this event is 400 participants which includes some of the "Old Hawthorne" neighborhood.

The City Special Events Committee has approved the application for this event pending Council approval. Conditions of approval have included following the noise ordinance for the downtown footprint of no amplified sound extending past 300 feet of the sound source.
