At their May 24, 2022 meeting, the Climate and Environment Commission voted to submit to City Council the attached letter seeking a Transit Task Force.

At the time of the discussion, a proposal by Public Works for a comprehensive transit study had not been approved in the FY-2023 budget. However, it has been made known to Sustainability staff that the PW study is included in next year's budget.
