Re: Department of Public Safety Grant – 2022-2023 STOP VAWA (Domestic Violence Unit Grant)

## Executive Summary

Staff has prepared for Council consideration an ordinance authorizing acceptance of the 2022-2023 STOP VAWA grant in the amount of \$169,358.67 from the Missouri Department of Public Safety and authorizing the City Manager to sign the contract.

## Discussion

This grant renewal will continue funding a portion of the two DOVE (Domestic Violence) Unit officer's salaries/benefits and provides 51% funding for a temporary part-time employee.

The contract period is January 1, 2022 through December 31, 2023.
