Re: Authorize a Cost Share Agreement with the Missouri Highways and Transportation Commission for the Scott Boulevard/Broadway (Christian Fellowship Road to Silvey Street))

Sidewalk Project.

Executive Summary

Authorize the City Manager to execute a cost share agreement with the Missouri Highways and Transportation Commission (MHTC) for construction of the Scott Boulevard/Broadway (Christian Fellowship Road to Silvey Street) sidewalk project at an estimated cost of \$696,600.

Discussion

On June 21, 2022, Council adopted Resolution 88-22 authorizing the City Manager to apply to the Missouri Department of Transportation (MoDOT) for the cost share grant for the Scott Boulevard/Broadway (Christian Fellowship Road to Silvey Street) sidewalk project. The Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP) provides federal funds for infrastructure projects that aid in non-motorized transportation. The program is administered through MoDOT. On August 1st, Staff received notification for the approved funding.

The Scott/Broadway Sidewalk project is located in western Columbia along Route TT. The project starts at the newly constructed sidewalk south of the Scott Boulevard and Christian Fellowship Road intersection. The sidewalk will extend northerly then easterly along Scott Boulevard. The road name changes from Scott Boulevard to Wales to West Broadway along the stretch of proposed sidewalk. The project ends at the intersection of Broadway with Silvey Street where there is existing sidewalk along the property on the east side of Silvey Street. The proposed sidewalk will be constructed along the northwest side of the road. In the length of sidewalk between Christian Fellowship Road and Route ZZ there is an asphalt shoulder that will be removed and replaced with a 6-foot wide concrete sidewalk at the back of the existing curb. From where the asphalt shoulder ends near Route ZZ to Silvey Street, curb and gutter with a 6-foot wide concrete sidewalk at back of curb will be constructed.

The proposed sidewalk will provide connectivity between subdivisions and businesses along the north side of the road. There has been an increase in development along the northwest side of the road including a new subdivision, gas station grocery store, etc. The sidewalk will also improve the connectivity to Smithton Middle School, Paxton Keeley Elementary School, Bonnie View Nature area, Daniel Boone Little League, and various other shops and businesses which are a little further from the project.

The project cost estimate is \$696,600 and funding for the City's match will be by the $\frac{1}{4}$ -cent Capital Improvement Program sales tax.



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Fiscal Impact

Short-Term Impact: Total cost for the City's match is anticipated to be \$250,776 and will be funded using the quarter-cent Capital Improvement Program sales tax.

Long-Term Impact: Sidewalks will be maintained by the adjacent property owners.
