Executive Summary

An ordinance authorizing the City Manager to sign the Public Health Emergency Preparedness Contract Amendment 03 between the City of Columbia and the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services. The contract amount shall not exceed \$183,252 for the period of July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023.

Discussion

The Public Health Emergency Preparedness contract between the City of Columbia and the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services provides funding for emergency preparedness activities related specifically to public health needs. The purpose of this contract is to demonstrate measurable and sustainable progress towards achieving public health and healthcare preparedness capabilities and to promote prepared and resilient communities.
