Re: Reduce the number of members on the Parking Advisory Commission

## Executive Summary

At the November 21, 2022 Council Meeting, Mayor Buffaloe asked that an ordinance be prepared to reduce the number of council appointed at-large members from six to four per the request of the Parking Advisory Commission.

## Discussion

The Parking Advisory Commission was established on December 18, 2017, and over the last year or two, the Commission has had to cancel a number of meetings due to quorum issues. In addition, there has been a lack of applicants when vacancies have been advertised. Currently, there are two vacancies.

The Parking Advisory Commission currently consists of nine members, six appointed by the council, and three appointed by the other entities (the University, the Downtown Community Improvement District, and the Downtown Columbia Leadership Council respectively). The Commission has recommended reducing the size of the Commission by two at-large seats via a letter dated September 8, 2022.

At the November 21, 2022 Council Meeting, Mayor Buffaloe asked that an ordinance be prepared to reduce the number of council appointed at-large members from six to four per the request of the Parking Advisory Commission, which in turn would reduce the number that constituted a quorum from five members to four members.

Since there are already two vacancies, this reduction would not impact current members from continuing to serve. The two vacant positions would be eliminated.
