Re: The Curators of the University of Missouri Agreement for Physician Services

Executive Summary

An ordinance authorizing the City Manager to sign the Agreement for Physician Services Contract and the Business Associate Agreement with the Curators of the University of Missouri for the period to include January 1, 2023 through December 31, 2023.

Discussion

This agreement allows the Department of Public Health and Human Services (PHHS) to have a University Physician serve as the Medical Director for PHHS. In this capacity, the Medical Director maintains a collaborative practice agreement with PHHS' advanced practice nurses and registered nurses, provides medical consultation or referral for patients receiving services at PHHS, provides medical consultation to PHHS administration regarding health department issues and programs, reviews and authorizes medical protocols, and serves as the public health representative on the Child Fatality Review Board. PHHS will reimburse The University for services provided by Dr. Dima Dandachi, at a cost of \$143 per hour, for up to twenty (20) hours per week. During periods of time when Dr. Dandachi is on leave, PHHS will reimburse the University for back-up coverage at the cost of \$165 per day. These costs align with previous agreements. The University Provides Professional Liability Coverage for its physicians.
