## **AN ORDINANCE**

amending Chapter 2 of the City Code to reduce the number of members on the parking advisory commission; and fixing the time when this ordinance shall become effective.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Chapter 2 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Columbia, Missouri, is hereby amended as follows:

Sec. 2-365.3. Membership; appointment; qualifications; terms.

- (a) The commission shall consist of <u>seven (7) nine (9)</u> members, appointed as follows:
  - (1) One (1) member shall be a representative of the University of Missouri appointed by the University of Missouri administration;
  - (2) One (1) member shall be a Downtown Community Improvement District (CID) representative appointed by the CID;
  - (3) One (1) member shall be a Downtown Leadership Council (DLC) representative appointed by the DLC; and
  - (4) Four (4) Six (6) members shall be appointed by the city council.
- (b) Commission members shall be residents and qualified voters of the city. Members shall serve without compensation. A member may not be a paid officer or employee of the city, be a party to any pending litigation against the city, or be an elected public office holder.
- (c) The four (4) six (6) members appointed by the city council shall initially be appointed to staggered terms as follows: two (2) members for a term of one (1) year, two (2) members for a term of two (2) years, and two (2) members for a term of three (3) years each. Thereafter, appointments made by the city council shall be for a term of three (3)

years, or until a successor is appointed and duly qualified, except that any appointment to fill a vacancy, occurring other than by expiration of a term, shall be filled for the unexpired term only. The members appointed by persons other than the city council shall serve for terms designated by the appointing authority and shall serve at the pleasure of the appointing authority.

Sec. 2-365.5. Meetings; quorum; attendance.

- (a) The commission shall meet at least quarterly at times and places accessible to the public to be determined by the commission. Special meetings may be called by the chair of the commission. All meetings shall be open to the public and shall comply with the requirements of the Missouri Sunshine Law and the Code of Ordinances of the City of Columbia.
- (b) Four (4) Five (5) members shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business.
- (c) The chair is authorized to excuse any member from attendance at a meeting; provided that the member requested to be excused before the meeting. Any member who is absent, without being excused, from fifty (50) percent of the regular commission meetings held in a calendar year shall automatically forfeit the office. Any member who is absent, without being excused, from three (3) consecutive regular meetings shall automatically forfeit the office. The chair shall promptly notify the city clerk and the appointing authority of any such vacancy.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
