AN ORDINANCE

amending Chapter 22 of the City Code relating to the provision of refuse bags for residential refuse customers; and fixing the time when this ordinance shall become effective. Filed in Clark's Offic

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Chapter 22 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Columbia, Missouri, is hereby amended as follows:

Material to be deleted in strikeout; material to be added underlined.

Sec. 22-159. Residential refuse customers.

(a) *Rates.* The following rates shall apply for the removal of refuse:

. . .

(b) <u>Reserved.</u> *Refuse bags.* Four (4) refuse bag vouchers per year will be provided to each residential unit paying the monthly rate for curbside pickup. Each voucher may be redeemed for twenty-six (26) refuse bags. Additional bags will be made available for purchase by the customer at a cost and location to be determined by the director. Beginning on February 1, 2021, refuse bags used for curbside pickup are required to display the city logo or other unique identifier established by the director.

. . .

(i) *Dimensions and weight.* All material for collection must be in a city provided refuse bag and shall not exceed fifty (50) pounds total weight per bag.

. . .

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
