Re: Amendment to an Agreement with Wilkes Boulevard United Methodist Church for Additional Homeless Drop-In Center Services

Executive Summary

A resolution authorizing the City Manager to sign an amendment to an agreement with Wilkes Boulevard United Methodist Church for additional homeless drop-in center services.

Discussion

The Wilkes Boulevard United Methodist Church (WBUMC) Turning Point program has begun providing homeless drop-in center services on Sundays from 12:30 – 4:30 p.m. Turning Point is providing Sunday services for the period of December 4, 2022 – April 2, 2023. These additional services are intended to address a gap in the community's daytime warming center capacity on weekends, on which the Activity & Recreation Center (ARC) and the Columbia Public Library are the only two available daytime warming centers. These Sunday services will relieve the burden on these facilities and offer both daytime warming and comprehensive drop-in center services to the unsheltered population.

Staff proposes an amendment to the social services provider agreement with Wilkes Boulevard United Methodist Church (WBUMC) for the Turning point program to include additional homeless drop-in center services in the agreement renewal term. The amendment increases the number of contracted units of service for the renewal term, the total allowable compensation from \$155,991.76 to \$183,489.58 for the renewal term, and alters the initial and renewal term payment amounts.
