Re: Agreements for the Purchase of Social Services

## Executive Summary

A resolution authorizing the City Manager to sign five (5) agreements for the purchase of social services.

## Discussion

The Department of Public Health and Human Services administers the City of Columbia process for the purchase of social services. In July, 2022, a request for proposals was issued for social services to address issues related to opportunity. Based on the review and rating of the proposals, the Human Services Commission and staff have recommended the City establish five (5) new purchase of service agreements with five (5) providers, for a total amount not to exceed \$365,117.55, as outlined in Exhibit A and conforming with the general form of the standard social services provider agreement (Exhibit B). The period for all agreements is January 1 – December 31, 2023.
