Executive Summary

An ordinance authorizing the City Manager to sign the Monkeypox Response Program Services Contract between the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services and the City of Columbia for a not to exceed amount of \$10,000 with a period beginning September 8, 2022 and ending June 30, 2023.

Discussion

This Program Services Contract, between the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services and the City of Columbia, for \$10,000 will support local public health efforts to prevent and respond to the Monkeypox outbreak and provide resources to mitigate STDs and HIV. Public Health and Human Services (PHHS) will conduct Monkeypox contact tracing, case investigations, vaccinations, health education, and outreach services.

This is a cost reimbursement contract. PHHS will be reimbursed for Monkeypox related expenses incurred beginning September 8, 2022 through June 30, 2023. This is a new, onetime, agreement that was unanticipated during the FY 23 budget process. Budget authority, pending Council approval, is included in the first quarterly budget amendment provided by the Finance Department. PHHS will use this funding to cover the temporary personnel related costs, advertising, medical supplies and mileage.
