


2. TREE PRESERVATION CALCULATIONS: CLIMAX FOREST AREA = 58,778 SQ FT

REQUIRED AREA TO BE PRESERVED - 25% = 14,694 SQ FT TOTAL AREA TO BE PRESERVED = 14,991 SQ FT 3. SIGNIFICANT TREE CALCULATIONS:

TOTAL SIGNIFICANT TREES = 10 (7 CONIFEROUS AND 3 DECIDUOUS) REQUIRED NUMBER OF TREES TO BE PRESERVED - 25% = 2.5 OR 3 TREES ALL 10 OF THE SIGNIFICANT TREES WILL BE REMOVED. 4 NEW CEDAR TREES AND 3 NEW DECIDUOUS TREES WILL BE PLANTED TO MEET THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE ORDINANCE.
