Project name and brief description: This project will include construction of five bus shelters. The locations will be at existing bus stops near the following intersections: Rollins St & Tiger Ave, Garth Ave & Sexton Rd, Brown School Rd & Edenton Blvd, Paris Rd & Hinkson Ave, and Paris Rd & Bus Loop 70. At each of the locations the bus shelter includes construction of a concrete pad and installation of the shelter structure. Staff is working with the adjacent property owners to acquire easements where the shelters will not be located completely in street right-of-way. The City term and supply contract will be used to construct the concrete pads. The bus shelters will be installed by City Staff. Construction is planned for this spring and summer.
