## AN ORDINANCE

imposing an additional sales tax of three percent (3%) on the retail sale of adult use marijuana; directing the City Clerk to provide notice of the sales tax to the Missouri Department of Revenue; directing the City Manager to provide mapping and geographic data to the Missouri Department of Revenue; and fixing the time when this ordinance shall become effective.

WHEREAS, amendments to Article XIV of the Missouri Constitution were approved by the voters on November 8, 2022 to remove state prohibitions on the purchase, possession, consumption, use, delivery, manufacture, and sale of marijuana for personal use for adults over the age of twenty-one (21); and

WHEREAS, such Constitutional amendment permits voters to consider and approve the imposition of an additional sales tax of three percent (3%) on the retail sale of adult use marijuana at a municipal, county or state general, primary or special election; and

WHEREAS, a majority of the qualified voters of the City of Columbia voting on the proposition of whether to impose an additional sales tax of three percent (3%) on the retail sale of adult use marijuana approved such sales tax at an election duly held on April 4, 2023.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to the votes cast by a majority of the qualified voters at an election held on April 4, 2023, an additional sales tax of three percent (3%) on the retail sale of adult use marijuana is hereby imposed within the City of Columbia.

SECTION 2. The City Clerk is hereby directed to forward a certified copy of this ordinance to impose an additional sales tax of three percent (3%) on the retail sale of adult use marijuana, and the certification of the election results on the proposition from the April 4, 2023 election, to the Director of Revenue of the State of Missouri by certified or registered mail within ten (10) days after passage of this ordinance.

SECTION 3. Pursuant to Section 32.310.3 RSMo., the City Manager, or designee, is hereby directed to ensure the mapping and geographic data pertaining to the City of Columbia's borders and jurisdiction are provided to the Missouri Department of Revenue to

accurately reflect the boundaries of the City for collection of the sales tax authorized herein. The City Manager, or designee, shall certify the accuracy of the data by affidavit and shall provide the data in a format specified by the Missouri Department of Revenue.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
