Re: Authorizing an Ordinance repealing Ordinance #024965 which authorized the acquisition of land in fee simple for Fire Station #10 on St. Charles Road.

## Executive Summary

Staff has prepared for Council consideration an ordinance repealing the acquisition of two properties in fee simple for the construction of City of Columbia Fire Station #10 on St. Charles Road authorized by Ordinance #024965 on March 21, 2022.

## Discussion

Previously Fire Station #10 was to be located north of and west of St. Charles Road, at the bend with the intersection of E. Richland Road. This location was determined to be not optimal due to a variety of factors including response times and roadway access. New locations for Fire Station #10 have been researched and negotiations on a new location have begun. However, this location is still important to Public Works due to the need for future intersection improvements. Therefore, there is additional legislation on this evening's agenda to address this need.
