Executive Summary

Staff has prepared for Council consideration a resolution granting a waiver from the requirements of Section 16-258 of the City Code to allow amplified family-friendly music for a concert at the Old Hawthorne Country Club for the MFA Annual Charity Golf Tournament on June 5, 2023.

Discussion

FPC Live, LLC., (d.b.a. The Blue Note) has requested a temporary waiver of Section 16-258 of the City Code to allow amplified music for a concert on private property for the MFA Annual Charity Golf Tournament. The event will take place in the parking lot of Old Hawthorne Country Club on Monday, June 5th, 2023 from 6:30 p.m. until 9:30 p.m. with an estimated overall attendance of 500.

This charity event has been produced by FPC Live, LLC for the last five years. There is snow fencing and bike rack barricades that are used to cordon off the event space and for alcohol containment.

The City Special Events Committee has reviewed the application. Per ordinance, a waiver is required when amplified sound can be heard more than 100 feet away from the source outside of the downtown foot print.
