Re: Department of Corrections TB testing Agreement

Executive Summary

An ordinance authorizing the City Manager to sign an Agreement between the City of Columbia and the Missouri Department of Corrections for the period of July 1, 2023 through June 30, 2024 for the purposes of administering and reading tuberculosis skin tests (TST).

Discussion

The Department of Corrections (DOC) contracts with the Columbia/Boone County Department of Public Health and Human Services (PHHS) to provide community-based tuberculosis skin testing to its employees, volunteers and interns. If tests are positive, PHHS provides education to the employee on the risks, consequences and treatment of tuberculosis infections. DOC reimburses PHHS \$20 per TST administration and reading. This is a one-year agreement, which may be renewed for two (2) additional one-year periods.
