AN ORDINANCE

amending Chapter 27 of the City Code as it relates to electric rates; and fixing the time when this ordinance shall become effective.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Chapter 27 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Columbia, Missouri, is hereby amended as follows:

Sec. 27-112. Same--Residential service rate.

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(c) *Monthly rate charge.* The monthly rate per kilowatt hour shall be as follows, subject to fuel power cost adjustments as provided in section 27-118:

Non-standard electric meter customer charge 21.54-35.02 per month

(d) *High efficiency heat pumps:* For customers having a permanently installed heat pump which is the primary source of comfort heating and which conforms to the special rules and regulations outlined in department rules entitled "Heat Pump Rules and Regulations," the monthly rate per kilowatt hour billed during the non-summer season for energy shall be as follows:

(e) *Minimum:* The minimum monthly rate charge shall be sixteen dollars and thirty-one cents (\$16.31) twenty-two dollars (\$22.00). The minimum monthly rate charge for customers with a non-standard electric meter shall be twenty-one dollars and fifty-four cents (\$21.54) thirty-five dollars and two cents (\$35.02).

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Sec. 27-114. Same--Small general service rate.

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(c) *Monthly rate charge:* The monthly rate per kilowatt hour shall be as follows, subject to fuel-power cost adjustments as provided in section 27-118:

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(d) *Outdoor area lighting.* Underground wire and conduit shall be installed and maintained by the customer for private street lighting for outdoor area (dusk to dawn) lighting. In addition to the one-time pole charge identified in section 27-121(c), the following rates shall apply for each light:

Sec. 27-121.1. Special outdoor lighting.

(a) Availability. The special outdoor lighting schedule is available for electrical service to sport field lighting, carnival, circus or holiday decorative lighting or similar temporary or seasonal use.

(b) *Type of service.* The type of service shall be single-or three-phase, sixty-hertz, at one of the department's standard service voltages.

(c) *Monthly rate charge.* The monthly rate per kilowatt hour shall be as follows, subject to fuel power cost adjustment as provided in section 27-118:

Customer charge\$56.10

Cost per Kwh 12.74-13.37 cents per kwh

SECTION 2. Chapter 27 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Columbia, Missouri, is further amended as follows:

Sec. 27-118. Same—*Power cost adjustment* Fuel adjustment allowance.

(a) <u>The city council may adopt a Power Cost Adjustment Procedure for</u> <u>implementation by the director, which may be revised from time to time consistent with the</u> <u>provisions of this article.</u>

(a-b) The monthly power cost adjustment (PCA) rate charge will be the average annual power cost per kwh above or below three and twenty-five five and seventy-six hundredths cents (\$-0325-0.0576) per kilowatt hour. In determining the fuel adjustment allowance under the formula set forth above, the energy cost shall be the sum of the following:

- (1) Average cost of fuel in the city's generating plant based on the net kilowatt hour generated in the city's plant;
- (2) Cost of purchased energy based on the net kilowatt hour purchased;
- (3) The monthly capacity costs (including the demand cost of purchased power) less the amount billed under special contract rates.

SECTION 3. The new rates established in Section 1 of this ordinance shall take effect on July 1, 2023, provided that rates for monthly charges shall be applied to utility bills beginning with the first cycle billed in July, 2023; and the new rates established in Section 2

of this ordinance shall take effect on October 1, 2023, provided that rates for monthly charges shall be applied to utility bills with the first cycle billed in October, 2023.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
