Re: Local Public Health Agency Infrastructure Contract

Executive Summary

An ordinance authorizing the City Manager to sign the Local Public Health Agency Infrastructure contract between the City of Columbia, MO and the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services for the period of August 1, 2023 through November 30, 2027 in an amount not to exceed \$425,639.

Discussion

The Local Public Health Agency Infrastructure grant is to be used to assist with providing or implementing activities to establish, expand, train, and sustain the public health workforce.

With these funds, Public Health and Human Services (PHHS) will offset the expense of existing staff, including a Health Program Coordinator (1.0 FTE) and a portion of the Community Health Worker Supervisor (.25 FTE). Funding will also be used to support staff development activities. This contract was included in the FY25 budget.
