Re: Destiny of H.O.P.E.

Executive Summary

A resolution authorizing the City Manager to sign an amendment to an agreement for services between Destiny of H.O.P.E. and the City of Columbia, MO.

Discussion

The City of Columbia received \$25.2 million in American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds to address the public health and economic impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic. On October 2, 2023, the City Council approved a resolution that instructed staff to negotiate agreements for Council consideration utilizing the ARPA funds. On December 4, 2023 Council authorized the City Manager to sign an agreement with Destiny of H.O.P.E to address community violence. The agreement is for \$320,000 and will end on January 31, 2027. This amendment will provide \$25,000 in startup funds which are included in the \$320,000, and therefore, will reduce the total number of services.
