

Introduced by Buffaloe Council Bill No. R 44-24

A RESOLUTION

setting a public hearing; declaring the necessity for the proposed installation of traffic calming devices on Spencer Avenue between Worley Street and I-70 Drive Southwest; stating the nature of and the estimate of the cost of the proposed improvement; providing source of funds for payment for the proposed improvement; and providing for compliance with the prevailing wage law.

WHEREAS, interested parties meetings for the proposed installation of traffic calming devices on Spencer Avenue between Worley Street and I-70 Drive Southwest, were held by the Public Works Department on April 25, 2023 and January 23, 2024.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. A public hearing in respect to the proposed public improvements set forth herein will be held in the Council Chamber of the City Hall Building, 701 E. Broadway, Columbia, Missouri at 7:00 p.m. on April 1, 2024. The City Clerk shall cause notice of this hearing to be published in a newspaper published in the City.

SECTION 2. The City Council deems the proposed installation of traffic calming devices on Spencer Avenue between Worley Street and I-70 Drive Southwest, necessary to the welfare and improvement of the City but desires to hear from the public prior to taking further action to authorize construction of the project. Specific improvements include the construction of three (3) speed humps as follows:

- Speed hump on Spencer Avenue near 512 Spencer Avenue.
- Speed hump on Spencer Avenue near 708 Spencer Avenue.
- Speed hump on Spencer Avenue near 811 Spencer Avenue

SECTION 3. The estimated cost of this proposed improvement is \$12,000.00.

SECTION 4. Payment for this proposed improvement shall be made from Annual Traffic Calming Funds and such other funds as may be lawfully appropriated.

SECTION 5. Any work done in connection with the construction of the proposed improvement specified above shall be in compliance with the provisions of the prevailing wage laws of the State of Missouri.
