#### **Executive Summary**

A resolution authorizing the transfer of \$3,500 from Council Reserve to Human Services Miscellaneous Contractual to support the Room at the Inn program of the Columbia Interfaith Resource Center.

#### Discussion

At its December 7, 2015 meeting, the City Council requested that a resolution be prepared by City staff to transfer \$3,500 from the Council Reserve to provide support for the Room at the Inn program of the Columbia Interfaith Resource Center. This program provides temporary winter emergency shelter to persons experiencing homelessness in Columbia. This resolution authorizes the transfer of \$3,500 from General Fund Council reserve to General Fund Human Services Miscellaneous Contractual, utilizing project number EHMLES which has been established for this specific purpose.
