BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Chapter 2 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Columbia, Missouri, is hereby amended as follows:

Sec. 2-251. Establishment; members; qualifications; appointment; terms.

The bicycle/pedestrian commission is hereby established. The commission shall be composed of eleven (11)-ten (10) members. One (1) member shall be a member of the planning and zoning commission chosen by that commission; one (1) member shall be a member of the parks and recreation commission chosen by that commission; one (1) member shall have knowledge of street construction and maintenance; four (4) members shall have knowledge of bicycling, bicycle safety, or bikeways; and four (4) members shall have an interest in pedestrian safety and infrastructure. All members shall be qualified voters of the city. The members succeeding the original members shall be appointed by the city council for three-year terms. The members from the planning and zoning commission and the parks and recreation commission shall be <u>a</u> voting members but shall not be eligible to serve as <u>an</u> officers of the bicycle/pedestrian commission.

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Sec. 2-347. Members; qualifications; compensation; terms.

The environment and energy commission shall be composed of eleven (11) ten (10) members. Four (4) members shall be appointed by the Boone County Commission. Six (6) members shall be appointed by the city council. One (1) member shall be a member of the planning and zoning commission chosen by that commission. The six (6) members appointed by the city council shall be qualified voters of the city. Members shall serve

without compensation and shall not be paid officers or employees of the city. The terms of office shall be three (3) years. Appointments shall be made on or about the first day of June of each year. The member from the planning and zoning commission shall be a voting member but shall not be eligible to serve as an officer of the environment and energy commission.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
