Executive Summary

The 2016 Show-Me STATE GAMES (SMSG) takes place June 10-12; July 22-24 and July 29-31. This agreement authorizes the city's sponsorship and support of the Games.

Discussion

The Show-Me STATE GAMES is known as the largest state games in the nation. Each summer thousands of athletes come to Columbia to compete in over 35 different sports. The SMSG generates a significant amount of overnight stays in Columbia hotels and provides substantial economic impact for Columbia.

The Convention & Visitors Bureau has allocated a cash sponsorship of \$16,800 for the 2016 Games. Columbia Parks & Recreation has allocated \$3,500 cash and approximately \$30,000 "in-kind" for the use of park facilities and other related services in support of the 2016 Show-Me STATE GAMES.

An agreement between the City and the Show-Me STATES GAMES is required prior to disbursement of city funds for the annual sponsorship and support of the Games.
