Re: Letter to City Council from Bicycle & Pedestrian Commission and Public Transit Advisory Commission re: street lighting at Providence Road and Carter Lane (Case #16-138)

Executive Summary

The Bicycle & Pedestrian Commission and Public Transit Advisory Commission have concerns about the adequacy of the street lighting at the intersection of Providence Road and Carter Lane. This location has proximity to COMO Connect transit stops and was the scene of a pedestrian fatality in early 2015. Their letter requests the implementation of lighting improvements at the intersection of Providence Road and Carter Lane.

The attached letter includes a request for improved street lighting at the intersection of Providence Road and Carter Lane, specifically to improve safety for COMO Connect transit riders and other pedestrians crossing in that vicinity. See letter for more details.
