#### Executive Summary

Staff has created for council approval an ordinance to enter a cooperative agreement with the Missouri Department of Conservation (MDC) for the creation of a Community Conservationist position. This position will be jointly funded by the City of Columbia and MDC starting in FY17.

#### Discussion

Attached for your consideration and approval is a Cooperative Agreement between the City of Columbia and the Missouri Department of Conservation (MDC). This is the first year of a potential multi-year program where MDC will provide financial support for a Community Conservationist position within the Office of Sustainability. The Community Conservationist will coordinate projects educating the community about the social, environmental, and economic benefits to urban conservation.

The position will take the place of the Sustainability Educator within the Office of Sustainability and begin in FY17. The Sustainability Educator position was grant funded and the end date is September 30, 2016.
