Re: Authorizing Right of Use Permits for Three Public Art Light Hubs within the City Rights of

Way

Executive Summary

Staff has prepared for Council consideration an ordinance authorizing the City Manager to execute three right of use permits with the Downtown Community Improvement District to install public art light hubs in the rights of way on Tenth Street, Fourth Street and Walnut Street.

Discussion

The Downtown Community Improvement District (CID) is requesting to install and maintain three public art light hubs within the following City rights of way:

Tenth Street right-of-way 40 feet south of its intersection with Ash Street

South Fourth Street right-of-way 40 feet north of its intersection with Cherry Street

Walnut Street right-of-way 110 feet east of its intersection with Fifth Street

A Civil Group has prepared construction plans for three Hub Story projects commissioned by the CID (see attached letter). The right of use permits for this project stipulate the conditions and obligations of the CID with respect to the use of City of Columbia electric power and the repair, modification, and relocation of the art installation. Location diagrams are attached to each of the right of use permits.
